

LITE AS A FEATHER

Some barrows can be cumbersome and too heavy. Well, according to **MARK HOLMES**, Prestige's new Porterlite 2 solves that problem.

Today's carp angler has all the kit but he increasingly needs to get to the bank quickly to secure a swim. Bulky two-wheeled barrows are not what are needed.

There are several things I look for in a barrow. The first requirement is that it should be a one-wheeled barrow. It allows greater manoeuvrability, balance and stores away in the boot easier. Secondly, I need a barrow that is strong enough to take the gear and not buckle. Lastly, and here is the catch, I want it to be light.

Up until now that has been almost impossible. In order to give strength, you need a heavy frame. However, the Prestige Porterlite 2 has cracked it. It is lightweight and still gives the strength needed.

Dispensing with side bars and a crossbar for your holdall, the balance of this barrow is what makes it a desirable bit of kit.

A superb feature is the inclusion of a free barrow bag. Within the bag there are two water bottles that make the carrying of the awkward

water butt a thing of the past.

Throw in grip handles and folding rear-leg assembly and once again Alan Silver, boss of Prestige, and the boys have come up with a winner.

Weighing a particularly light 10.75kg, this folds away neat and tidy in the back of the car.

For the short-session or overnight angler who needs to be quick and mobile, this is the barrow for you.
